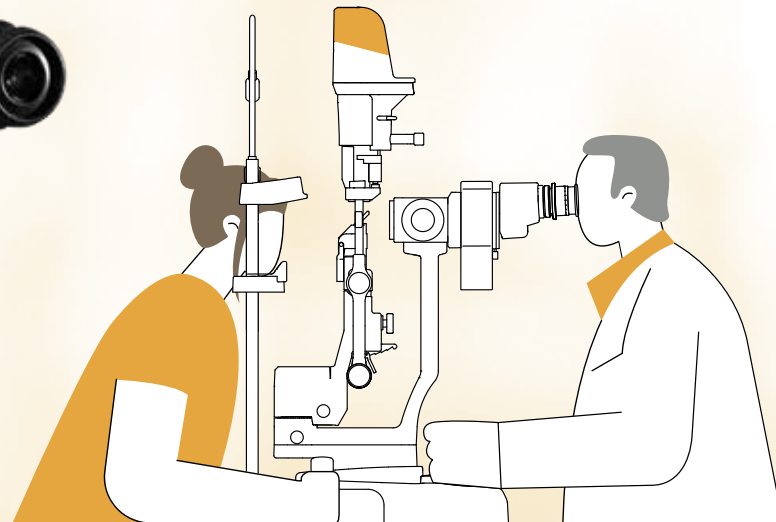


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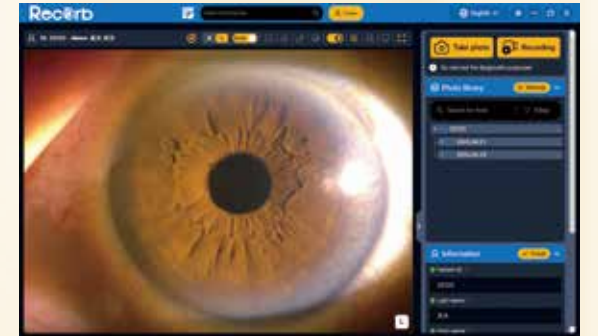

Guidance is displayed at application startup to support smooth operation.

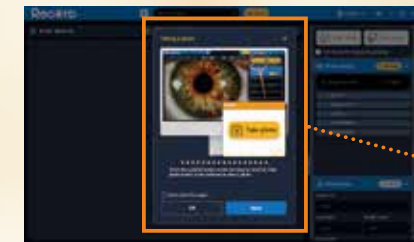


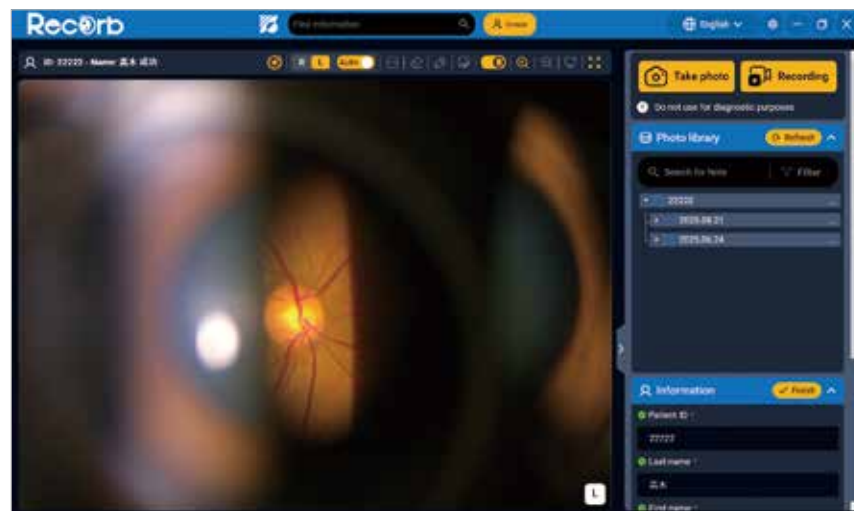
Image capture

Auto exposure and color tone adjustment functions are designed to enhance visibility in high-contrast areas and aid information capture during observation.

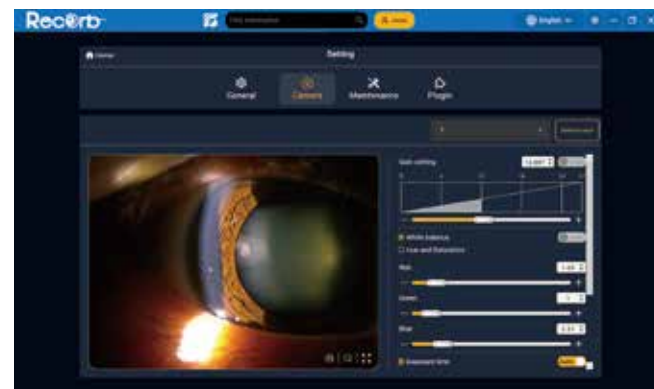


Auto exposure

Brightness is automatically adjusted according to illumination conditions to facilitate image capture.

Color tone adjustment

Hue, saturation, and brightness can be adjusted while viewing the live image. Gain, white balance, and exposure time can also be adjusted automatically, with a design focused on ease of viewing and comparison.



Supports an environment that facilitates image and information sharing with patients

Designed with consideration for image display and patient information management, it supports a clinical environment that enables clear patient communication and efficient information review.

Dual-display capability

Captured still images and videos can be clearly displayed on a patient-facing monitor, facilitating confirmation and explanation during examinations.



The camera is equipped with a yellow filter as standard, convenient for fluorescence observation.

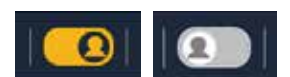
Up to four images for comparison

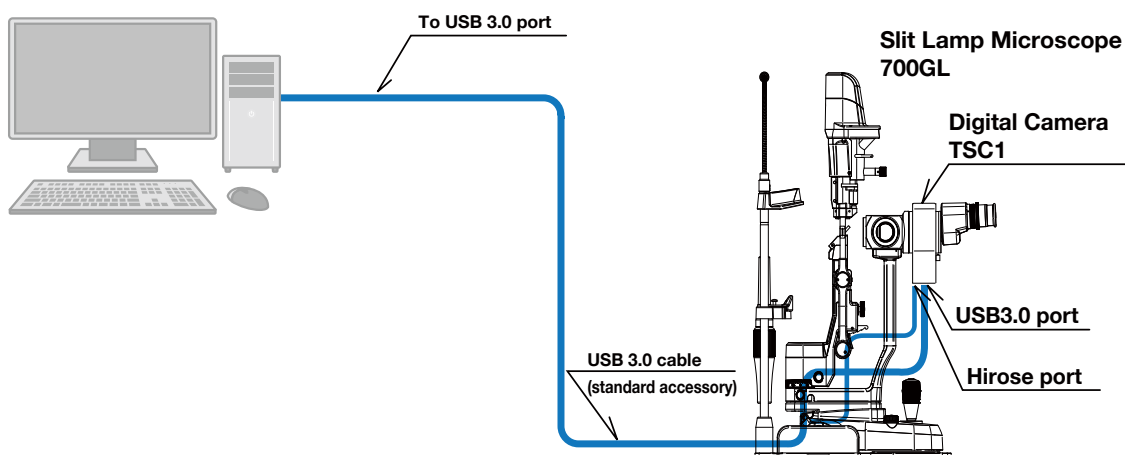
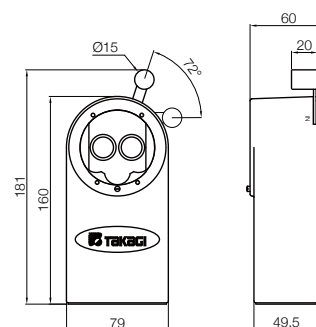
