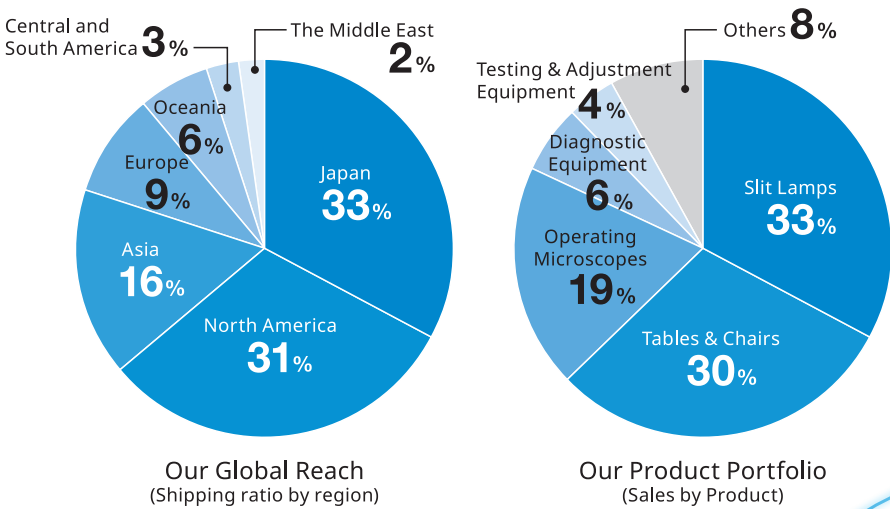

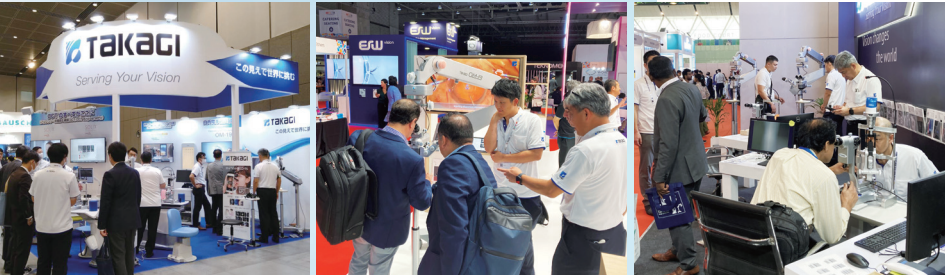

- 1965 Started integrated production of slit lamps, from parts processing to final assembly
- 1972 Acquired medical device manufacturing license, established the TAKAGI brand, reorganized to Takagi Mfg. Co., Ltd. - and started exporting overseas
- 1973 Launched TAKAGI brand's first slit lamp, the MT303 series
- 1976 Launched TAKAGI brand's first operating microscopes, MT361 and MT363
- 1978 First domestic exhibition at the 23rd International Congress of Ophthalmology (Kyoto, Japan)
- 1986 First overseas exhibition at the 25th International Congress of Ophthalmology (Rome, Italy)
- 1990 Reorganized to Takagi Seiko Co., Ltd.
Appointed Kazutoshi Takagi as the president
- 1998 Achieved ISO9001
- 2000 Opened Osaka Sales Office (Osaka-shi, Osaka, Japan)
- 2004 Achieved ISO13485
